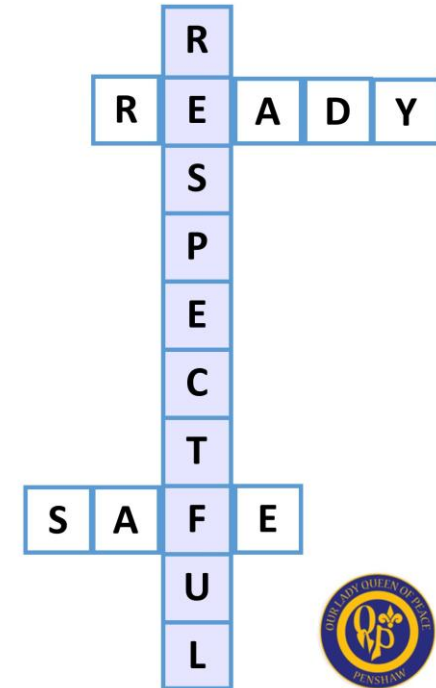


# What are our school rules?
